

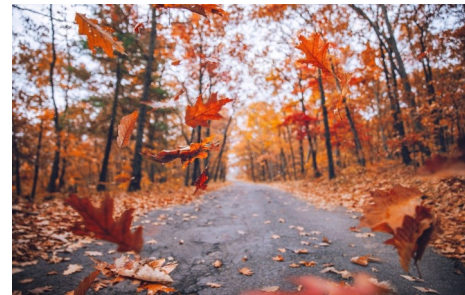

Forest	A large area covered with trees, shrubs and plants.
Seasons	The four divisions of the year (Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter).
River	A large natural stream of water.
Valley	Land that runs between hills or mountains with a river flowing through it.
